Reviewer Diversity	JOEAC strives for a diversified reviewer pool to ensure a balanced evaluation encompassing various perspectives and methodological approaches.
Confidentiality	Reviewers' identities are kept confidential from authors throughout the review process. This fosters unbiased evaluations based solely on the manuscript's merit.
Review Criteria	Manuscripts are evaluated based on the following criteria aligned with: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Originality and significance of the research question • Soundness of the research methodology • Clarity and coherence of writing • Adherence to latest APA style guidelines for referencing and formatting • Contribution to the field of education and culture.
Review Timeline	Authors can expect a review decision within [Max. 10 Days] of manuscript submission.
Revision Process	If revisions are requested, authors will be given clear instructions and a reasonable timeframe to address reviewer feedback.
Editorial Decision (Through Email)	The final decision to accept, reject, or request revisions rests with the Editor-in-Chief, considering reviewer recommendations.
Transparency	While reviewer identities remain confidential, authors will receive detailed feedback reports outlining the strengths and weaknesses of their manuscript as identified by reviewers.
